## Abbreviations (UK terms)

Ch Chain

dc Double Crochet

tr Treble Crochet

FPtr Front Post Treble Crochet

st(s) Stitch(es)

## What you will need:

- Knitcraft Cotton Blend in White (yarn A), Hot Pink (Yarn B), Lilac (Yarn C), Light Blue (Yarn D), Bright Blue (Yarn E), Teal (Yarn F), Yellow (Yarn G), Mustard (Yarn H), Coral (Yarn I)
- 5mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

## Pattern Notes

- Ch1 at the beginning are for turning and do not count as a stitch.
- Ch2 count as a tr stitch.
- This square uses the alpine stitch
- For the majority of the square you will only work along 2 sides of the square.
- When working the front post treble stitch, pull up the stitch to the height of the current row to prevent curling of the square.
- Front post treble stitches are worked around the post of the treble stitch 2 rows below while treble crochet stitches are worked into the double crochet stitches in the row below.
- When working a front post treble stitch, the corresponding stitch in the DC row will be left unworked.



Row 1. Ch4, 2tr in 4th ch from hook, ch2, 3tr in same sp, turn. (6 sts)



Row 2. Ch1, dc in next 3 sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-2-sp, dc in next 2 sts and in top of beg 4 ch, turn. (8 sts)



Row 3. Ch3, tr in next 3 sts (tr, ch1, tr) in ch-2 -p, tr in next 4 sts, turn. (10 sts)







Row 4. Ch1, dc in next 5 sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in Ch-1-sp, dc in next 4 sts, dc in top of beg ch3, turn. (12sts)



Note: Make sure to work FPtr around the tr 2 rows below and tr into the dc sts in the row just worked.

Row 5. Ch3, (FPtr, tr) twice, tr in next st, (tr, ch1, tr) in ch-2-sp, tr in next st, (FPtr, tr) twice, tr in last st, turn. (14sts)



Row 6. Ch1, dc in next 7 sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-1-sp, dc in next 6 sts, dc in top of ch3, turn. Fasten off. (16sts)





Join Yarn B:

Row 7. Ch3, tr, (FPtr, tr) 3 times, (tr, ch1, tr) in ch-2-sp, tr in next 2 sts, (FPtr, tr) 3 times, turn. (18 sts)

Row 8. Ch1, dc in next 9 sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-1-sp, dc in next 8 sts, dc in top of ch3, turn. Fasten off. (20sts)



Join Yarn C:

Row 9. Ch3, (FPtr, tr) 4 times, tr in next st, (tr, ch1, tr] in ch-2-sp, tr in next st, (FPtr, tr) 4 times, tr in last st, turn. (22 sts)

Row 10. Ch1, dc in next 11 sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-1-sp, dc in next 10 sts. dc in top of Ch3, turn. (24 sts)



Join Yarn D:

Row 11. Ch3, tr, (FPtr, tr) 5 times, (tr, ch1, tr] in ch-2-sp, tr in next 2 sts, (FPtr, tr) 5 times, turn. (26 sts)

Row 12. Ch1, dc in next 13 sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-1-sp, dc in next 12 sts, dc in top of ch3, turn. (28sts)



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Join Yarn E:

Row 13. Ch3. (FPtr, tr) 6 times, tr in next st, (tr, ch1, tr) in ch-2-sp, tr in next st, (FPtr, tr) 6 times, tr in last st, turn. (30sts)

Row 14. Ch1, dc in next 15 sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-1-sp, dc in next 14 sts, dc in top of Ch3, turn. (32sts)



Join Yarn F:

Row 15. Ch3, tr, (FPtr, tr) 7 times, (tr, ch1, tr) in ch-2-sp, tr in next 2 sts, (FPtr, tr) 7 times, turn. (34sts)

Row 16. Ch1, dc in next 17 sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-1-sp, dc in next 16 sts, dc in top of Ch3, turn. (36sts)



Join Yarn G:

Row 17. Ch3, (FPtr, tr) 8 times, tr in next st, (tr, ch1, tr) in ch-2-sp, tr in next st, (FPtr, tr) 8 times, tr in last st, turn. (38sts)

Row 18. Ch1, dc in next 19 sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-1-sp, dc in next 18 sts, dc in top of Ch3, turn. (40 sts)



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Join Yarn H:

Row 19. Ch3, tr, (FPtr, tr) 9 times, (tr, ch1, tr) in ch-2-sp, tr in next 2 sts, (FPtr, tr) 9 times, turn. (42sts)

Row 20. Ch1, dc in next 21 sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-1-sp, dc in next 20 sts, dc in top of Ch3, turn. (44 sts)



Join Yarn I:

Row 21. Ch3, (FPtr, tr) 10 times, tr in next st, (tr, ch1, tr) in ch-2-sp, tr in next st, (FPtr, tr) 10 times, tr in last st, turn. (46 sts)

Row 22. Ch1, dc in next 23 sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-1-sp, dc in next 22 sts, dc in top of Ch3, turn. (48sts)



Join Yarn A:

Row 23. Ch3, tr (FPtr, tr) 11 times, (tr, ch1, tr) in ch-2-sp, tr in next 2 sts, (FPtr, tr) 11 times, turn. (50sts)

Row 24. Ch1, dc in next 25 sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-1-sp, dc in next 24 sts, dc in top of Ch3, turn. (52sts)

Row 25. Ch3, (FPtr, tr) 12 times, tr in next st, (tr, ch1, tr) in ch-2-sp, tr in next st, (FPtr, tr) 12 times, tr in last st, turn. (54sts)

Row 26. Ch1, dc in next 27 sts, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-1-sp, dc in next 26 sts, dc in top of Ch3, turn. (56sts)





Note You will now work on all 4 sides of your square to finish off. \*\*

Rnd 27. Ch1, dc 28 evenly across first side, (dc, ch2, dc) in the corners. \*dc 27, (dc, ch2, dc) in the corner rep from \* once more, dc 28 evenly along the last side, ch2 and ss to 1st dc. (29 each side)

Rnd 28. Ch1, \*dc 29, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-2-sp for the corner, rep from \* three more times, ss to 1st dc. Fasten off. (31 sts each side)



Once you've finished your square, sew in all ends.
