



Pattern Notes

Materials

Knitcraft Cotton Blend (50% Cotton, 50% Acrylic; 100g/215m) in:
Yarn A (YA): White x 9 balls
Yarn B (YB): Yellow x 1 ball
Yarn C (YC): Bright Blue x 1 ball
Yarn D (YD): Hot Pink x 2 ball
Yarn E (YE): Lilac x 1 ball
Yarn F (YF): Teal x 2 ball
Yarn G (YG): Mustard x 2 ball
Yarn H (YH): Light Blue x 2 ball
5mm hook
Stitch markers



Tension

15 sts and 19 rows over double crochet on 5mm hook.
Work a tension square on 5mm hook Ch 26.
Row 1: 1dc in 2nd ch from the hook, dc in each ch to end, turn. 25 sts
Rows 2-30: 1ch (does not count as a stitch), dc in each st across, turn.
Fasten off.
If you have more sts to 10cm use a smaller hook, if you have less sts to 10 cm use a larger hook.

Measurements

150cm/59in x 130cm/51in after blocking

Abbreviations

Bobble = bobble stitch
CC = contrasting colour
ch = chain
ch-sp = chain space
dc = double crochet
dtr = double treble
foll = following
hk = hook
htr = half treble crochet
lp = loop
nxt = next
prev = previous
puff = puff stitch
rep = repeat
sk = skip
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitches
tr = treble crochet
yrh = yarn around hook
YA/YB etc = yarn A/ yarn B etc
RS/WS = right side/wrong side
[.] = repeat instructions inside square brackets the given number of times
(.) = work the stitches inside the round brackets into one stitch

Pattern Notes

·The pattern is written using UK terminology.
·Whilst tension is not important for this blanket, it will have an effect on the amount of yarn used.
·Starting and turning chains do not count as stitches unless stated.
·Colour changes are made with the last yrh of the previous st before new colour is needed. If a new colour is required at the start of a row then the colour should be changed with the last yrh of the final st of the prev row.
·When working the tapestry crochet sections, please note whether preparation of smaller yarn balls is required before starting. Always gently pull carried yarn before changing colour to ensure it lays flat within the work.
·When working from the tapestry crochet charts, odd number rows are worked from right to left (RS) and even number rows are worked from left to right (WS). The charts just show the main repeat. Work from the written pattern until the position of the charts are established

Special Stitches

Puff stitch:

[Yrh, insert hook into st, yrh, pull through] five times, yrh, pull through all 11 lps on hook.

V puff stitch:

*[Yrh, insert hook into st, yrh, pull through] five times, yrh, pull through all 11 lps on hook; once, 1ch, rep from * once more in same st to complete a V puff st.

Bobble stitch (made on WS of work):

*Yrh, insert hook into st, yrh, pull through, yrh, pull through 2 lps; rep from * three more times in same st, yrh pull through all 5 loops on hook.

Berry stitch (made on WS of work):

Yrh, insert hook into st, yrh, pull through, yrh, pull through 1 lp, yrh, insert hook into same st, yrh, pull through, yrh, pull through all 5 loops on hook.

V stitch:

*Yrh, insert hook into st, yrh, pull through, yrh, pull through 2 lps, yrh, pull through 2 lps; once, 1ch, rep from * once more in same st to complete a V st.

Dtr bobble:

*Yrh twice, insert hook into st, yrh, pull through, [yrh, pull through 2 lps] twice; rep from * three more times, yrh, pull through all 5 lps on hook.

3ch-picot:

Work prev st as directed, 3ch, sl st in third ch from the hook, continue working pattern as directed (nb. the 3ch-picot sits above a stitch rather than counting as a st itself).

Colour changes:

Double crochet -

With first colour, insert hook into st, yrh, pull through, release first colour, yrh with second colour, pull through both lps on hook.

Half treble crochet -

With first colour, yrh, insert hook into st, yrh, pull through, release first colour, yrh with second colour, pull through all 3 lps on hook.

Treble crochet -

With first colour, yrh, insert hook into st, yrh, pull through, yrh, pull through 2 lps, release first colour, yrh with second colour, pull through both lps on hook.
