WEEK 4

STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

NB - These instructions use **UK** crochet terms throughout - **US** terms are given in square brackets below where applicable

ch - chain

cl - cluster (a group of 3 stitches all worked into the same place)

cm - centimetres

dc - double crochet [US single crochet]

dc2tog - double crochet 2 together [US single crochet 2 together]

dtr - double treble [US triple treble]

htr - half treble [US half double crochet]

in - inch(es)

rep - repeat

rnd - round

sp - space

ss - slip stitch

st(s) - stitch(es)

tr - treble [US double crochet]

Notes

Since this square is worked in the round, the right side of the work is always facing you.

Sew your ends in with a tapestry needle, weaving back and forth through the back of your work.

Always leave a tail of 15cm, (6in) when changing yarns or fastening off so you can sew in at least 8cm, (3in) to secure your work.

WEEK 4 CAL PATTERN FLOWER POWER

Make 4 in Colourway 1 and 4 in Colourway 2

Foundation Chain. Using **Yarn D (Colourway 1)** or **Yarn B (Colourway 2)** and 4.00 hook make 4ch, ss into 1st ch to form a ring.

1st Rnd. 3ch (3ch counts as 1tr), 1 ltr into centre of ring, ss into 3rd ch. Total of 12tr. Fasten off.

2nd Rnd. **Yarn A (Colourway 1)** or **Yarn G (Colourway 2)**:- Join in Yarn A or Yarn G with ss join into any tr, 3ch, 1tr into tr on which 3ch stands, 2tr into each of next 1 ltr, ss into 3rd of 3ch.



FLOWER POWER

This week we combine all the techniques we have learnt so far to create the Flower Power motif! Like the Spotty Dotty square, we first create a circular centre then add petals before we square off.

My top tip for this square is make sure you count and check your stitches at the end of each row. There are a few different increases so it's good to double check your numbers before the square off stage.

Make 4 motifs in each colourway, 8 in total.

THIS WEEK'S STITCH HOW TO'S

CHAIN

To start, make a slip knot and place loop on hook. To make 1 chain, yarn over hook and draw yarn through loop on hook.

SLIP STITCH

Insert hook into the stitch or space indicated in pattern, yarn over hook and draw yarn through both the stitch or space and loop on hook.

TREBLE CROCHET STITCH

Yarn over hook, insert hook into stitch or space indicated in pattern, yarn over hook, draw yarn through stitch or space (3 loops on hook), yarn over hook and draw yarn through 1st 2 loops on hook (2 loops left on hook), yarn over hook and draw yarn through last 2 loops on hook.

DOUBLE CROCHET STITCH

Insert hook into stitch or space indicated in pattern, yarn over hook, draw yarn through stitch or space (2 loops on hook), yarn over hook and draw yarn through both loops on hook.

NEW THIS WEEK - DOUBLE CROCHET 2 TOGETHER

Insert hook into stitch indicated in pattern, yarn over hook, draw yarn through stitch (2 loops on hook), insert hook into next stitch, yarn over hook, draw yarn through stitch (3 loops on hook), yarn over hook and draw yarn through all 3 loops on hook.

DOUBLE TREBLE CROCHET STITCH

(Yarn over hook) twice, insert hook into stitch or space indicated in pattern, yarn over hook, draw yarn through stitch or space (4 loops on hook), yarn over hook and draw yarn through 1st 2 loops on hook (3 loops left on hook), yarn over hook and draw yarn through 1st 2 loops on hook (2 loops left on hook), yarn over hook and draw yarn through last 2 loops on hook.

HALF TREBLE CROCHET STITCH

Yarn over hook, insert hook into stitch or space indicated in pattern, yarn over hook, draw yarn through stitch or space (3 loops on hook), yarn over hook and draw yarn through all 3 loops on hook.

FASTEN OFF

With the last loop still on hook, cut the yarn (leaving a long enough tail for weaving the end in) then yarn over hook and draw end of yarn all the way through loop on hook. Pull tight to secure.

Total of 24tr.

Fasten off.

3rd Rnd. Yarn E (Colourway 1 and Colourway 2):- Join in Yarn E with ss join into any tr, 1ch (1ch counts as 1dc), * 5tr into next tr, (1dc into next tr) 3 times, * rep from * to * 4 times more, 5tr into next tr, (1dc into next tr) twice, ss in between 1ch and 1st tr. Total of 6 5tr petals with 3dc in between each petal.

4th Rnd. 1ch (1ch counts as 1dc), * 1tr into 2nd of 5tr, (2tr into next tr) twice, 1tr into next tr, 1dc into next dc, dc2tog over next 2dc, 1dc into next tr, * rep from * to * 4 times more, 1tr into next tr, (2tr into next tr) twice, 1tr into next tr, 1dc into next dc, dc2tog over next 2dc, ss in between 1ch and 1st tr.

Total of 6 6tr petals with 3dc in between each petal.

5th Rnd. 1ch, * 1htr into 2nd of 6tr, (2tr into next tr) 3 times, 1htr into next tr, 1dc into next dc, dc2tog over next 2dc, 1dc into next tr, * rep from * to * 4 times more, 1htr into next tr, (2tr into next tr) 3 times, 1htr into next tr, 1dc into next dc, dc2tog over next 2dc, ss between 1ch and 1st htr. Fasten off.

Total of 6 (1htr, 6tr, 1htr) petals with 3dc in between each petal.

6th Rnd. Yarn B (Colourway 1) or Yarn D (Colourway 2):- Join Yarn B or Yarn D with a ss join into 5th of 6tr in any petal, 1ch (1ch counts as 1dc), * miss next 3 sts, (3tr into next dc) twice, miss next 3 sts, 1dc into next tr (this is the 3rd of 6tr at top of petal), 2dc into next tr, 1dc into next tr, * rep from * to * 4 times more, miss next 3 sts, (3tr into next dc) twice, miss next 3 sts, 1dc into next tr, 2dc into next tr, ss into 1ch.

Total of 60 sts - 4dc at the top of each petal and 6tr in between each petal.

7th Rnd. 6ch (6ch counts as 1dtr, 2ch), 3dtr into 1st tr, * miss next 2 sts, 3tr into next st, miss next 2 sts, 3htr into next st, miss next 2 sts, 3tr into next st, miss next 2 sts, (3dtr, 2ch, 3dtr) into next st, * rep from * to * twice more, miss next 2 sts, 3tr into next st, miss next 2 sts, 3htr into next st, miss

next 2 sts, 3htr into next st, miss next 2 sts, 3tr into next st, miss next 2 sts, 2dtr into same tr as 1st 3dtr, ss into 4th of 6ch.

Total of 6 cl along each side edge. Fasten off and weave in ends.
