### Mushroom

Using Red

- R1: 6dc into a magic ring (6)
- R2: (2dc into next st) 6 times (12)
- R3: (Dc, 2dc into next st) 6 times (18)
- R4: (2dc, 2dc into next st) 6 times (24)
- R5: (3dc, 2dc into next st) 6 times (30)
- R6: (4dc, 2dc into next st) 6 times (36)
- R7 - R10: Dc all around (36)
- R11: BLO (4dc, inv dec) 6 times (30)
- R12: (3dc, inv dec) 6 times (24)
- R13: (2dc, inv dec) 6 times (18)
- Change to Grey
- R14: FLO dc all around (18)
- R15 - R19: Dc all around (18)
- R20: (Dc, inv dec) 6 times (12)
- FO and weave in any left over yarn.

### Mushroom Spots

Make 5

Using White

- R1: 5dc into a magic ring, ss to close (5)
- FO and weave in any left over yarn.

NOW - Attach the spots to the top of the mushroom.

Embroider eyes with scrap black yarn and white.

### Apron

Using Rice Pudding

- R1: Ch13, dc in 2nd st from hook, dc all across ch (12)
- R2 - R6: Ch1, turn, dc all across (12)
- R7 - R13: Ch2, turn, htr all across (12)
- R14: Ch1, turn, dc around all 4 sides with 2dc in each corner.
- FO and weave in any left over yarn.

### Apron Straps

NOTE - Attach the yarn 6 rows up from the bottom.

### Waist straps

Make 2)

Using Rice Pudding


- R1: Ch35, ss in 2nd st from hook and in each ch (34)
- FO and weave in any left over yarn.

### Arm straps

(Make 2)

Using Rice Pudding

- R1: Ch15, ss into the apron 3 rows apart, (15)
- NOTE - Attach the arm straps from the top corner to 3 rows down.
- Left side arm strap go from top to bottom and the righthand arm strap from bottom to top.





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### Shawl

(NOTE - Leave a long tail before making the chain.

Using Plum

R1: Ch25, starting in 2nd st from the hook (2dc, 2dc into next st) 8 times (32)

R2: Ch1, turn, (2dc, 2dc into next st) 10 times, 2dc (42)

R3: Ch1, turn, (2dc, 2dc into next st) 14 times (56)

R4 - R8: Ch1, turn, dc all along (56)  
FO and leave a long tail.

NOW - Weave the tail through the rows till you reach round one. Then wrap the shawl around the neckline and with the two tails tie a bow.

### Hat

Using Plum

R1: 5htr into a magic ring (5)

R2: (2htr in next st) 5 times (10)

R3: (2htr in next st) 10 times (20)

R4: Htr all around (20)

R5: (2htr in next st) 20 times (40)

R6: (4htr, 2htr in next st) 8 times (48)

R7: Htr all around (48)

R8: (5htr, 2htr in next st) 8 times (56)

R9: (6htr, 2htr in next st) 8 times (64)

R10: (7htr, 2htr in next st) 8 times (72)

R11: Htr all around (72)

R12: (8htr, 2htr in next st) 8 times (80)

R13 - R14: Htr all around (80)

R15: (8htr, inv dec) 8 times (72)

R16: 36 ss, 36dc (72)

FO and weave in any left over yarn.



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
