have lots of corners

Inner corners - Where we have joined two hexagons together and the two hexagons meet via the centre 2<sup>nd</sup> tr of the 3tr that make the corner/centre point.

Outer corners - Where the corners are pointing out and are made with 3tr, the 2<sup>nd</sup> or the 3tr is your corner/centre point

## Method

Join yarn A into any tr

### Round 1

1dc in each tr until you reach an outer corner, work 1dc, ch1, 1dc into each outer corner st. 1dc in each tr until you reach the inner corner, 1 dc2tog first leg of dc2tog in centre st of the inner corner of current hexagon, second leg of dc2tog in centre st of next hexagon.

Repeat all the way around and join with slst to the first dc or round.

### Round 2

1tr in each stitch until you reach the outer corner, 1tr, ch2, 1tr in the outer corner st, 1dc in each dc until you reach the inner corner, missing out the dc2tog from previous round work tr2tog, first leg of tr2tog in last dc of current hexagon, second tr2tog in first dc of the next hexagon, repeat all the way around and join with a slst to the first tr of round.

### Round 3

Ch3 (counts as htr and ch1), skip 1st, 1htr in next, ch1, repeat in each tr until you reach the outer corner.

In outer corners, work 1htr, ch2, 1htr into ch2 sp, continue with 1htr, ch1 sk 1 until you reach the inner corners, work htr2tog, with first leg of htr2tog last tr of current hexagon, skip tr2tog of row below, working second leg of htr2tog in first tr of next hexagon, slst to the first htr of round.

### Round 4

## Materials

Knitcraft Cotton Blend in A  
4mm Crochet Hook  
Scissors  
Tapestry needle

## Abbreviations

ch – chain  
slst – slip stitch  
dc – double crochet  
dc2tog – double crochet two together  
tr – treble crochet  
tr2tog – treble crochet two together  
mb – make bobble

Due the way hexagons have been joined we now

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Ch1, 1dc in same st. 1dc in each dc and each ch space until you reach an outer corner ch2 sp, mb, continue with 1dc in each dc and each ch space until you reach an inner corner mb into the top of the tr2tog from the previous round, don't forget your dc in the ch space either side of the tr2tog.

Join with a slst to the first dc of round. Fasten off yarn and weave in all loose ends.
