





Rnd 1: With yarn A, 12tr into a magic ring, ss to 1st tr to join (12sts)



Rnd 2: Continue in Yarn A, ch 1, (doesn't count as a stitch) 2tr into each stitch around, ss in the 1st tr (not the chain) to join. (24sts) Fasten off yarn A.



Rnd 3: Join yarn B. Standing tr to begin the round (alternatively join yarn and ch 2 and count this as a stitch), 1tr into the same st, 1tr in next st, \*2tr in next st, 1tr into the next st, rep from \* to the end of the round, ss in top of 1st st. (36sts) Fasten off yarn B.









## Rnd 4: Join Yarn C

Standing dc, (alternatively join yarn and ch 1 and count this as a st), 1dc in same st, 1dc into the next 2 sts, \*2dc in next stitch, 1dc in next 2 sts, rep from \* to the end of the round, ss in top of 1st stitch. (48sts)



Rnd 5 (WS): Ch 2, turn, \*2 loops in same st, 1 loop in next 3 sts, rep from \* to the end of the round, ss in top of 1st st. (60sts)



Rnd 6 (RS): Ch 1 and turn, 2dc in same st, 1dc in next 4 sts, \*2dc in next st, 1dc in next 4 sts, rep from \* to the end of the round, ss in top of 1st st. (72sts)

















Rnd 7: Ch 2 turn, \*2 loops in same st, 1 loop in next 5 sts, rep from \* to the end of the round, ss in top of 1st st. Fasten off yarn C and turn work to RS facing for next row.



Rnd 8: Join Yarn D, ch3 (counts as 1dtr), (1dtr, ch 2, 2dtr) all in same st, \*1dtr in next 2 sts, 1tr in next 3 sts, 1htr in next 3 sts, dc in next 4 sts, 1htr in next 3 sts, 1tr in next 3 sts, 1dtr in next 2 sts, \*\* (2dtr, ch 2, 2dtr) all in same st, rep from \* 3 times more, ending at \*\* on last rep, ss in top of ch3. (96, 20 stitches on each side 4 in each of the corners)



Rnd 9: Continue in yarn D, ch 2 (counts as a st), 1tr, \*(1tr ch 2, 1tr) all into corner ch-sp, tr in each st to next corner ch-sp, rep from \* for each side ending last side at ch2 at beg of rnd, ss in top of ch2. Fasten off. (104sts in total, 24sts stitches on each side 2 in each of the corners)

















Rnd 10: With yarn B, join yarn and ch 1, \*1dc in each st to a corner, (1dc, ch 2, 1dc) all into the corner ch-sp, rep from \* to the end of the round, ss in top of 1st st. (112sts)



Now at this point you can sew in your ends and cut the loops to give the furry effect of the Mop Monster.



For the reflection on the monster's eye.

With yarn B in a magic ring ch 1, (doesn't count as a stitch) 6dc into the magic ring. ss in top of 1st dc not the chain. Fasten off.

Sew into place using the photo as reference
