



Croissant

Using Mustard, make a Mc.

Rnd 1. 6dc in mc (6dc)

Rnd 2. [1dc, 2dc into next st] 3 times (9dc)

Rnd 3. 1dc in each st around (9dc)

Rnd 4. [2dc, 2dc into next st] 3 times (12dc)

Rnd 5. 1dc in each st around (12dc)

Rnd 6. [3dc, 2dc into next st] 3 times (15dc)

Rnd 7. 1dc in each st around (15dc)

Rnd 8. [4dc, 2dc into next st] 3 times (18dc)

Rnd 9. 1dc in each st around (18dc)

Rnd 10. [5dc, 2dc into next st] 3 times (21dc)

Rnd 11. 1dc in each st around (21dc)

Rnd 12. [6dc, 2dc into next st] 3 times (24dc)

Rnd 13. 1dc in each st around (24dc)

Rnds 14-19. 8dc, 2htr, 4tr, 2htr, 8dc (24sts)

Start to stuff with fibre filling.

Rnd 20. 1dc in each st around (24dc)

Rnd 21. [6dc, dc2tog] 3 times (21dc)

Rnd 22. 1dc in each st around (21dc)

Rnd 23. [5dc, dc2tog] 3 times (18dc)

Rnd 24. 1dc in each st around (18dc)

Rnd 25. [4dc, dc2tog] 3 times (15dc)

Rnd 26. 1dc in each st around (15dc)

Rnd 27. [3dc, dc2tog] 3 times (12dc)

Rnd 28. 1dc in each st around (12dc)

Rnd 29. [2dc, dc2tog] 3 times (9dc)

Rnd 30. 1dc in each st around (9dc)

Rnd 31. [1dc, dc2tog] 3 times (6dc)

Rnd 32. 1dc in each st around (6dc)

Fasten off leaving a long tail, thread through rem sts draw up and fasten off.

Pastry Wrap

Using Mustard, ch21.

Row 1. 1dc in the 2nd ch from hook, 19dc, turn (20dc)

Rows 2-4. Ch1, 1dc in each st, turn (20dc)

Row 5. Ch1, dc2tog, 18dc, turn (19dc)

Rows 6-9. Ch1, 1dc in each st, turn(19dc)

Row 10. Ch1, dc2tog, dc to end, turn (18dc)

R11-85. Continue to repeat R6-10 another 15 times more. (3dc)

Fasten off leaving a long tail to sew around the base of the Croissant, wrap around with the widest part (Row 1) positioned at the back of the Croissant.
