



Moon and Star Moon

Using Light Grey, make a Mc.

Rnd 1. 6dc in mc (6dc)

Rnd 2. [2dc into next st] 6 times (12dc)

Rnd 3. [1dc, 2dc into next st] 6 times (18dc)

Rnd 4. [1dc, 2dc into next st] 9 times (27dc)

Rnd 5. [2dc, 2dc into next st] 9 times (36dc)

Insert the 1st safety eye between Rnd 4 and Rnd 5 and the 2nd between Rnd 7 and Rnd 8.

Rnd 6. [2dc, 2dc into next st] 12 times (48dc)

Rnd 7. [3dc, 2dc into next st] 12 times (60dc)

Rnd 8. [3dc, 2dc into next st] 15 times (75dc)

Rnd 9. [4dc, 2dc into next st] 15 times (90dc)

Rnd 10. [4dc, 2dc into next st] 18 times (108dc)

Rnd 11. [5dc, 2dc into next st] 18 times (126dc)

Fold the round in half without fastening off.

Rnd 12. Ch1, 1dc through both sides of the round and dc shut.

Before completing Rnd 12, stuff with fibre filling.

Fasten off and sew in the ends. With a small amount of Black, embroider a simple mouth.

Star (make 2 and sew together) Using Yellow, make a Mc.

Rnd 1. 5dc in mc (5dc)

Rnd 2. [2dc into next st] 5 times (10dc)

Rnd 3. *[dc, htr] in next st, picot, [htr, dc] in next st, rep from * 4 times more, sl st to 1st dc.

Fasten off and sew both stars together with RS facing out. Sew star to moon.

With a small amount of Black, embroider a simple mouth and eyes.
