### Abbreviations (UK terms)

Ch – chain

Ss – slip stitch

St(s) – stitch(es)

Dc – double crochet

Htr – half treble crochet

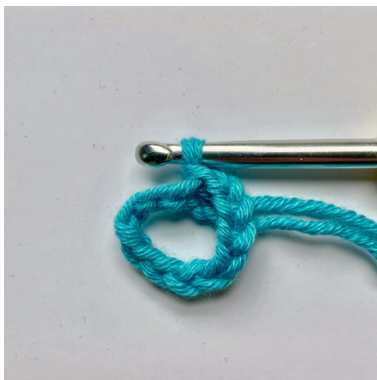
Tr – treble crochet

Dtr – double treble crochet

### What you will need:

- Knitcraft Cotton Blend in Bright Blue (yarn A), Teal (yarn B), Yellow (yarn C), Mustard (yarn D), Hot Pink (yarn E), Denim (yarn F), Purple (yarn G)
- 5mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

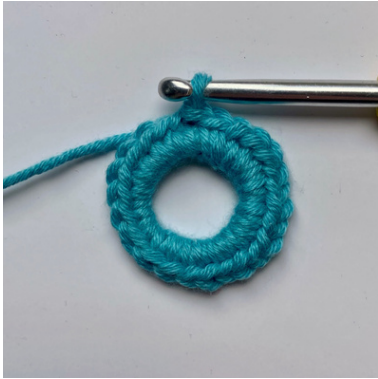
With yarn A, ch 12. Join to the first chain with a ss to form a ring..



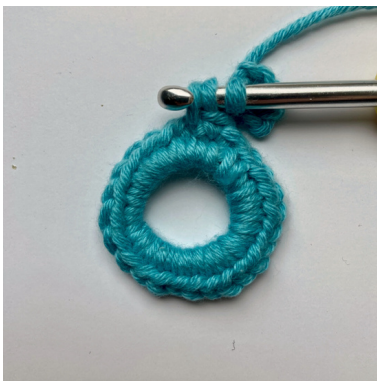




Rnd 1 Ch 1 (does not count as stitch) dc 24 into the ring (you might need to push the stitches together as you go), ss to the first dc. (24 stitches).



Rnd 2 Ch 1 (don't count as a stitch) dc in the same stitch as the ss join. dc in next stitch, ch 8 and ss to the front of dc (through the front loop of the stitch and the front 'prong' of the dc), (1dc in next 2 sts, ch 8 and join with a ss to the front of the dc as before) 11 times, ss to first dc, fasten off bright blue. (24 dc and 12 ch loops)



Rnd 3 With yarn B, join in any dc without the 8 chs and ch 3 (or standing tr), tr in next stitch, ch 8 and ss to the front of the tr (through front loop of stitch and front 'prong'), ( tr 1, ensuring that the 8 bright blue chains are in front of the round, tr in next stitch and ch 8, ss to front of stitch as before) 11 times, ss to first tr (or top of chain 3) and fasten off. (24 tr and 12 loops)

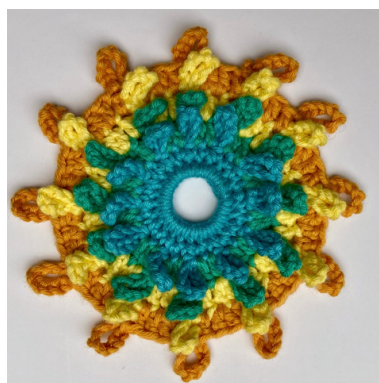




Rnd 4 With yarn C, join in any tr after a tr with chains and ch 3 (or standing tr), 2tr into next st, ch 8 and ss to the front of the stitch (through the front loop of the stitch and the front 'prong'), ( tr 1, ensuring that the chains from the previous rounds are in front of the round, 2tr into next st, ch 8, ss to the front of the stitch as before) 11 times, ss to the top of the first tr (or top of chain 3) and fasten off. (36 tr and 12 loops)



Rnd 5 With Yarn D, join in any tr after a tr with chains and chain 3 (or standing tr), 2tr into next st, tr 1, ch 8 and ss to the front of the stitch (through the front loop and the front 'prong'), (tr 1, ensuring that the chains from the previous rounds are in front of the round, 2tr into next st, tr 1, ch 8 and ss to the front of the stitch as before) 11 times, ss to the top of the first tr (or top of chain 3) and fasten off. (48 tr and 12 loops)



Rnd 6 With yarn E, join in any tr after tr with chains and ch 3 (or standing tr), tr3, ch 8 and ss to the front of the stitch (through the front loop and front 'prong'), (tr 4, ensuring that that chains from the previous rounds are in front of the round, chain 8, ss to the front of the stitch as before) 11 times, ss to the top of the first tr (or top of chain 3) and fasten off. (48 tr and 12 loops) it may start to curl slightly but will flatten out after the next few rounds.



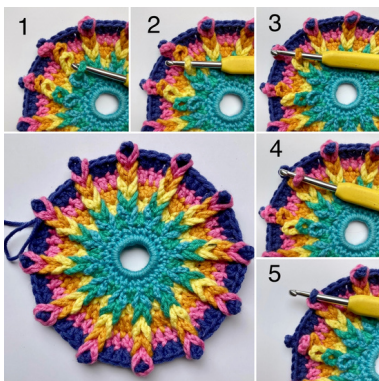




Rnd 7 Join yarn F in any tr after a tr with chains and ch 3 (or standing tr), tr1, 2tr in next st, tr 1, ch 3, ss to the front of the stitch (through the front loop and front 'prong'), (tr 1, ensuring the chains from previous rounds are in front of the round, tr 1, 2tr in next st, tr 1, ch 3, ss to the front of the stitch as before) 11 times, ss to the top of the first tr (or top of chain 3) Don't fasten off. (60 tr and 12 loops).



Use the crochet hook to join all the chains together to form a ladder





Rnd 8 With yarn F; ch 3 (counts as a tr) tr1, (dtr 2, ch 2, dtr 2) in next st, tr 2, dc into the denim loop from the previous round, [htr 1, dc 4, ss 1 into the loop, dc 4, htr 1, dc 1 into the loop, tr 2, (dtr 2, ch 2, dtr 2) in next st, tr 2, dc into loop] 3 times, htr 1, dc 4, ss 1 into the loop, dc 4, htr 1, dc 1 into the loop, ss to top of chain 3. (16 dtr, 16 tr, 8 htr, 40 dc, 4 ss totalling 84 stitches)



Rnd 9 Ch 3 (Counts as a stitch) tr 3, \*(tr2, ch 2, tr2,) into corner sp, tr 21, rep from \* 3 times, tr 17, ss to top of chain 3. (100 sts and 4 ch-2-sps)



Rnd 10 Join yarn G with a standing htr stitch (or ch 2) in one of the corners, htr1, ch1, htr2 into same corner sp, \*htr 25, (htr2, ch1, htr2) into corner, rep from \* 3 times, htr 25, ss to start of round and fasten off. ( 116 htr and 4 2ch spaces).







Rnd 11 Rejoin yarn F with a standing stitch (or ch 1), dc around the square in the third loop (at the back) of each htr with (dc 1, ch2, dc 1) in each corner. (124 dc and 4 2ch spaces)
