When autumn arrives, Hattie is just as happy. She spends the season with Toadie the toadstool, jumping in the fallen leaves and enjoying the wildlife that autumn brings with it.

Materials

Sirdar Snuggle DK in Treehouse
Sirdar Snuggle DK in Rice Pudding
Wl Premium Acrylic in Honey
Wl Premium Acrylic in Mustard
Wl Premium Acrylic in Plum
Wl Premium Acrylic in Grey
Wl Premium Acrylic in Vanilla
Wl Premium Acrylic in Cream
Wl Premium Acrylic in red
Wl Premium Acrylic in White
Hayfield Bonus DK in Primrose
Wl Soft and Cuddly in Light Blue
Wl Soft and Cuddly in Light Pink
Wl Soft and Cuddly in Lilac
Wl Soft and Cuddly in Mint
3mm Crochet Hook
Toy Stuffing
Darning Needle
Embroidery Thread
Scissors
Stitch Markers
Sewing Pins

Abbreviations (UK terms)

Ch = chain st = stitch
Ss = slip stitch
Dc = single crochet htr = half treble
Tr = treble
Htr - half treble
Yoh - yarn over hook
Inv dec = invisible decrease (insert hook into front loop only of next st, pull through loop) twice, yoh and pull through 3 loops.
(..) = Repeat the process in the brackets
FO = Fasten off
R = Round/Rows
BLO = Back loops only
FLO = Front loops only



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Making the doll

NOTE - Hattie doll is made in one piece from legs to head. Stuff the legs as you go.

Leg One

Using Vanilla

R1: 6dc into a magic ring (6)

R2: (2dc in next st) 6 times (12)

R3: (dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times (18)

R4 - R11: Dc all around (18)

Change to Mint

R12 - R14: Dc all around (18)

FO and weave in any left over yarn.

Leg Two (Vanilla)

Repeat the process of Leg One

R1 - R14 like leg 1 but DO NOT cut yarn or FO.

Body

NOTE - Stuff the body as you go.

R15: Ch3, ss into leg 1, 18dc into leg 1, 3dc across the ch, 18dc around leg 2, 3dc across other side of ch (42)

R16 - R17: Dc all around (42)

Change to Vanilla

R18 - R20: Dc all around (42)

Change to Mint

R21 - R23: Dc all around (42)

Change to Vanilla

R24: Dc all around (42)

R25: (5dc, inv dec) 6 times (36)

R26: Dc all around (36)

R27: (4dc, inv dec) 6 times (30)

R28: (3dc, inv dec) 6 times (24)

R29: (2dc, inv dec) 6 times (18)

R30: Dc all around (18)

NOW - Continue making the head.

Stuff the head as you go.

Head

R31: (2dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times (24)

R32: (3dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times (30)

R33: (4dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times (36)

R34: (5dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times (42)

R35: (6dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times (48)

R36: (7dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times (54)

R37 - R44: Dc all around (54)

R45: (7dc, inv dec) 6 times (48)

R46: (6dc, inv dec) 6 times (42)

R47: (5dc, inv dec) 6 times (36)

R48: (4dc, inv dec) 6 times (30)

R49: (3dc, inv dec) 6 times (24)

R50: (2dc, inv dec) 6 times (18)

R51: (dc, inv dec) 6 times (12)

R52: (inv dec) 6 times (6)

FO and weave in any left over yarn.

Arms

NOTE - No need to stuff the arms.

(Make 2)

Using Vanilla

R1: 5dc into a magic ring (5)

R2: (2dc in next st) 5 times (10)

R3 - R15: Dc all around (10)

R14: Squash end flat, 5dc across the opening through 2 sts each time to close.

FO and leave a tail for attaching to the arms.



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NOW - Attach the arms to the side of the body approximately 4 rows down from the neck line. Weave in any left over yarn.

Hair

Using Honey

R1: 6dc into a magic ring (6)

R2: (2dc into next st) 6 times (12)

R3: dc, 2dc into next st) 6 times (18)

R4: (2dc, 2dc into next st) 6 times (24)

R5: (3dc, 2dc into next st) 6 times (30)

R6: (4dc, 2dc into next st) 6 times (36)

R7: (5dc, 2dc into next st) 6 times (42)

R8 (6dc, 2dc into next st) 6 times (48)

R9: (7dc, 2dc into next st) 6 times (54)

R10 - R19: Dc all around (54)

R20: 11dc, 2htr, 5tr, htr, dc, 2ss, dc, htr, 5tr, 2htr, 23dc (54)

FO and leave a long tail for attaching to the top of the head. Weave in any left over yarn.

NOW - Attach the hair to the top of the head. Make sure the back of the hair is in line with the neck line so it sits at a slight angle.

Hair Bunches

NOTE - Add a little stuffing to the hair bunches.

Make 2

Using Honey

R1: 3dc into a magic ring (3)

R2: (2dc into next st) 3 times (6)

R3: Dc all around(6)

R4: (2dc into next st) 6 times (12)

R5 - R7: Dc all around (12)

R8: (inv dec) 6 times (6)

R9: Dc all around (6)

FO and leave a tail for attaching to the hairline. Weave in any leftover yarn.

NOW - Attach the hair bunches to either side of the head.

Weave in any left over yarn.

Embroider on the eyes using White and scrap black yarn, nose using vanilla and cheeks using light pink .



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
