

# GRANNY SQUARE MONTH

knit  craft

## Finishing

### Abbreviations (UK terms)

Ch - chain  
Tr - treble crochet  
Sp - space  
Ss - slip stitch  
St(s) - stitch(es)  
Rep - repeat  
Rnd - round

### What you will need:

- For border: 6 colours of your choice. We used: Knitcraft Cotton Blend in Grey (yarn A), Hot Pink (yarn B), Teal (yarn C), Coral (yarn D), Lilac (yarn E), Red (yarn F),
- For joining use yarn A
- 5mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

### Pattern Notes

Make sure when selecting the colours for the joining and border that you have a good amount left.

If needed you can add extra stitches to each side if you find the edges aren't sitting flat. If you do this make sure the stitch count for each side is a multiple of 6 + 5.

Starting 1ch does not count as st.



## Joining

Before joining block each square to the correct 20cm x 20cm measurements. If needed you can add an extra row in the last colour you used around any squares that are slightly smaller.

Lay out squares in the correct order.

Take 2 squares and with RS facing together and your chosen colour, attach yarn with a ss to one corner.

Working into back loops only, ss across row to join the 2 squares together.

Continue joining each square in this way until all squares are joined. Some squares may have more stitches than others so it is best to pin the beginning and end of each square together to make sure they fit nicely.

## Edging

For the edging select colours that you have a good amount of yarn left over to work with or follow the colours selected below.

With RS facing, attach yarn A to any corner.

Row 1: Ch1, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) into corner, \*work approx. 153tr across edge to next corner (30 tr in 2 squares, 31 tr in 3 squares), (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) into corner sp, rep from \* twice more, 153tr across final edge, ss into top of 1st dc. Fasten off. (155sts on each side)

Row 2: With yarn B, attach to any corner sp, 3ch (counts as 1tr), 6tr into corner, [skip 2 sts, 1dc into next st, \*skip 2 sts, 5tr into next st, skip 2 sts, 1dc, rep from \* to 2 sts before next corner, skip 2 sts, 7tr into corner] 3 times more omitting last 7tr cluster, ss to top of 3ch. Fasten off.

Row 3: With yarn C, attach to any middle corner st, ch1, 1dc into same st, [\*5tr into next dc st, skip 2sts, 1dc into next st, skip 2 sts, 5tr into next dc, rep from \* to next corner, dc into middle corner st] 3 times more, omitting last dc, ss to 1st dc. Fasten off

Row 4: With yarn D, attach to any corner dc, 3ch, (2tr, 2ch, 3tr) into same st, [\*1htr, 3dc, 1htr, 1tr, rep from \* to last 5 sts before corner, 1htr, 3dc, 1htr, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) into corner] 3 times more, omitting last corner, ss to top of 3ch. Fasten off

Row 5: With yarn E, attach to any corner sp, 3ch, (2tr, 2ch, 3tr) into corner sp, \*1tr into each st, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) into corner, rep from \* omitting last corner st, ss to top of 3ch. Fasten off.

Row 6: With yarn F, attach to any corner sp, 1ch, \*(1dc, 1ch, 1dc), 1dc into each st, rep from \* to end, ss to 1st dc. Fasten off.

Sew in all ends.

Block blanket.
