



GRANNY SQUARE MONTH



Pattern Notes

Each square has been designed to measure approximately 20cm by 20cm using Knitcraft Cotton Blend. If you find your square is coming out bigger or smaller, it is worth changing your hook size. Another option is to add another row to your square or remove a row.

Each square will need to be blocked after making. We would also suggest to block the finished blanket and border.

If adjoining squares have a slightly different number of stitches along the joining edge, simply skip a stitch on the side with more stitches when joining. If more than one stitch needs to be skipped, make sure you space them out evenly. This won't be noticeable overall. It may be helpful to hold the edges together with removable/hinged stitch markers or safety pins when joining

All abbreviations will be listed on each pattern and will be UK terms.

This is a great project for using up your stash and being creative so don't be afraid to switch up the colours in each pattern. See recommended yarn amounts to help you create your own colour palette.

What you will need:

- Knitcraft Cotton Blend in White x 2, Hot Pink x 2, Teal x 2, Bright Blue x 2, Yellow x 2, Mustard x 1, Red x 1, Light Blue x 1, Coral x 1, Black x 1, Lilac x 1, Light Grey x 1, Denim x 1, Purple x 1.
- 5mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Small amount of stuffing
- 1 small button
