# **Knitcraft Water Garden** Introduction









# The Water Garden

#### **Materials**

Knitcraft Cotton Blend yarn bundle 4mm crochet hook Scissors Tapestry needle

### Abbreviations and stitch instructions (pattern used UK terms)

ch - chain

sl st - slip stitch

**dc** – double crochet - insert hook into st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through both loop **htr** – half treble crochet - yarn over, insert hook into st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through all three loops

**tr –** treble crochet - yarn over, insert hook into st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over pull through two loops, yarn over pull through two loops

**dtr** – double treble crochet - yarn over twice, insert hook into st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through two loops, yarn over, pull through two loops **ttr** – triple treble crochet

**2dtr cl –** two double treble cluster - yarn over twice, insert hook into the st, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over pull through two loops, yarn over pull through two loops, two loops left on hook, yarn over twice, insert hook into the st, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over pull through two loops, yarn over pull through two loops, yarn over pull through two loops

**3dtr cl –** three double treble crochet - yarn over twice, insert hook into the st, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over pull through two loops, two loops left on hook, yarn over twice, insert hook into the st, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over pull through two loops, yarn over pull through two loops, yarn over pull through two loops, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over pull through two loops, yarn over pull through two loops, four loops left on hook, yarn over pull through all four loops

**dc2tog** – double crochet two together – insert hook into st, yarn over, pull up a loop, do not complete stitch, insert hook into next st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through three loops

**dc3tog** – double crochet three together - insert hook into st, yarn over, pull up a loop, do not complete stitch, insert hook into next st, yarn over, pull up a loop, do not complete st, insert hook into next st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through four loops

**tr2tog** – treble crochet two together – yarn over, insert hook into st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through two loops, yarn over, insert hook into next st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through two loops, yarn over, pull through three loops

**tr3tog** – treble crochet three together - yarn over, insert hook into st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through two loops, yarn over, insert hook into next st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through two loops, yarn over, insert hook into next st, yarn over, pull through two loops, yarn over, pull through four loops

**mb** – make bobble - 5tr into the st, remove hook and insert into the top of the first tr, then back into the loop, yarn over, pull through both loops on hook

**spc** – starting popcorn - ch3, 4tr into st, remove hook and insert into top of ch3 and back into loop you just took your hook out of, pull loop through tr

**pc** – popcorn – 5tr into st, remove hook and insert into top of ch3 and back into loop you just took your hook out of, pull loop through tr

picot - picot - ch3, slst into first ch

## Pattern notes

When joining in new yarn, join on last pull through of previous colour.

Tension is not important for this project as long as you keep it the same throughout.

The finished blanket is approx 56 inches at it's longest point, the size will vary depending on individual tension.
