## Day 2

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### Abbreviations (UK terms)

Ch – chain  
Rnd – round  
Ss – slip stitch  
Ch-sp – chain space  
Beg – beginning  
St(s) – stitch(es)  
Yrh – yarn round hook  
Dc – double crochet  
Tr – treble crochet  
Dtr – double treble crochet

### What you will need:

- Knitcraft Cotton Blend in
- Yellow (yarn A), Mustard
- (Yarn B), Denim (yarn C),
- Light Blue (yarn D)
- 5mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle

Scissors

### Pattern Notes

Standing dc – make a slip knot on your hook, insert hook into stitch, yrh, pull the loop back through the stitch (2 loops on hook) yrh and pull through both loops on hook

Puff stitch – (yrh, insert hook into st, yrh and pull up a loop) twice, yrh and pull through all 5 loops on hook.

Popcorn – work 5 tr into same st, remove hook from working st and insert hook, from front to back, into the top of the first tr, replace working loop back on hook and pull through to complete the popcorn.

Blo – back loop only

Fp – front post – work the stitch indicated around the post, from front to back, instead of in the top of the stitch

Bp – back post – work the stitch indicated around the post, from back to front, instead of in the top of the stitch.





Fptr3tog - front post treble three together – \*yrh, insert hook around post of st, from front to back, yrh pull the loop back through the stitch (3 loops on hook) yrh pull through two loops\* 3 times (4 loops on hook) yrh pull through all loops on hook.

Fpdtr2tog - front post double treble two together – Yrh twice, insert hook around post from front to back, yrh, pull loop back through the st (4 loops on hook). Yrh, pull through 2 loops twice (2 loops on hook).

Yrh twice, insert hook around the 2nd post from front to back, yrh, pull loop back through the st (5 loops on hook), yrh, pull through 2 loops twice (3 loops on hook), yrh, pull through remaining 3 loops on hook.

With Yarn A, ch 5 and SS join to form a ring or

Rnd 1: With yarn A make a magic ring, ch 2 (counts as htr) work 11 htr into ring, ss into top of beg ch-2.

Close magic ring. Fasten off.

(12 htr)



Rnd 2: With yarn B, attach yarn in any st and ch 3 (counts as tr)

\*fptr around post of same st just worked, tr in next st \* rep from \* to \* 10 times more.

Fptr around post of same st just worked, ss to top of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

(24 stitches; 12 tr, 12 fptr)

Tip: the top of the tr may be hidden behind the fptr just made, so you may have to dig with your hook for the stitch.







Rnd 3: With yarn A, begin in any tr with a standing dc  
Work a fptr3tog around the post of the next fptr  
\* dc in next tr, fptr3tog around next fptr \* rep from \* to \* 10 times more.  
Ss into first dc made. Fasten off.  
(12 fptr3tog, 12 dc)



Rnd 4: With yarn B, begin with a standing dc in any dc  
Work a fptr around the tr below from rnd 2 (same colour yarn, you may have to dig for it)  
Fpdc around top of the next fptr3tog  
\* dc in next dc, fptr around tr from rnd 2, fpdc around top of next fptr3tog \*, rep from \* to \* 10 times more.  
Ss to first dc made. Fasten off.  
(12 dc, 12 fptr, 12 fpdc)



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Rnd 5: Background section.

Tip: miss out all fptr's in this round.

With yarn C, attach yarn in a fpdc and ch 3 (counts as tr)

Tr again in same st, work 2 tr in next dc

\* skip fptr, work 2 tr in fpdc, work 2 tr in dc \*

Repeat from \* 10 times more, SS to top of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

(48 tr)



Rnd 6: Use yarn B and work in the back loops only

Tip: When working in the back loop, I also place my hook through the hidden 3rd loop behind the stitch, this gives a much tighter, neater finish.

Start with a standing dc in blo, of the first tr worked after a skipped stitch, dc in blo of next tr

Now work a fpdtr2tog; work the first dtr leg around the fptr to the right (rnd 4 same colour) and the 2nd dtr leg around the fptr to the left (rnd 4 same colour) Skip 1 st,

\* dc in blo of each of the next 3 sts, work a fpdtr2tog with first dtr to the right (this will already have a st around it) and the 2nd dtr to the left; both around the fptrs of rnd 4, skip 1 st \*

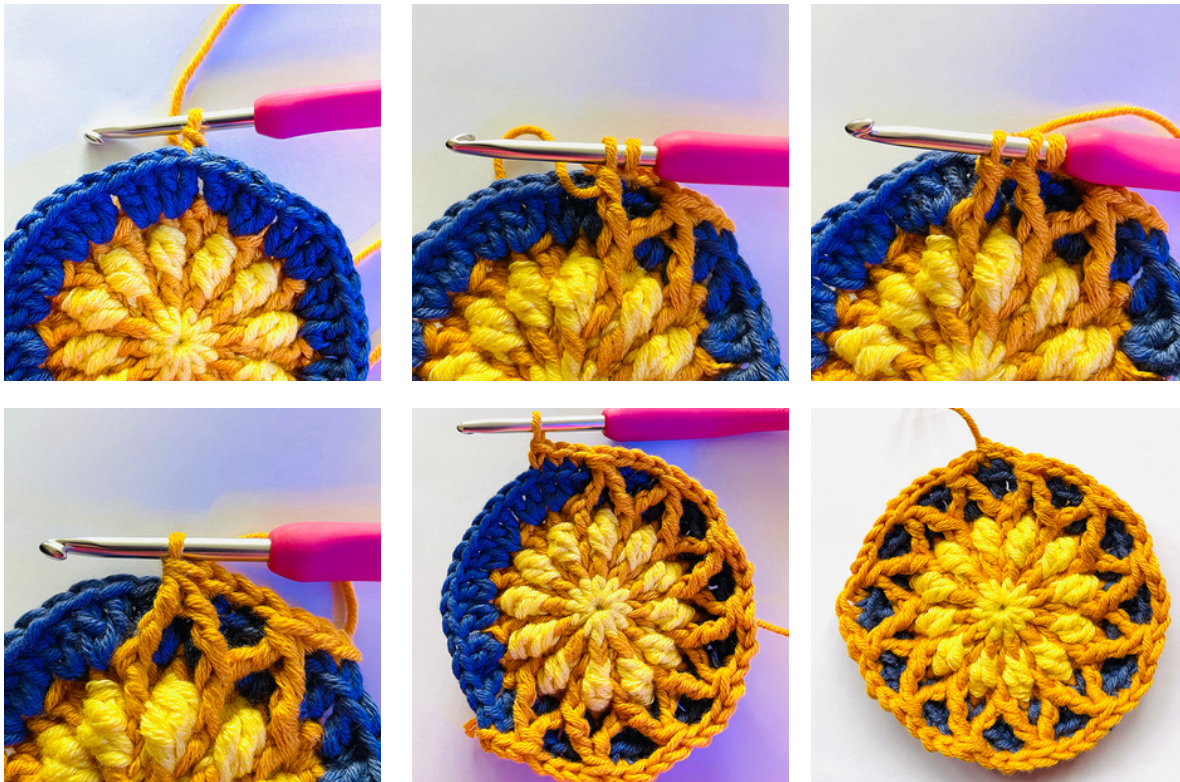
Repeat from \*to\* 10 times more, dc in blo of the last st, then ss to first dc made. Fasten off.

(12 fpdtr2tog, 36 dc blo)

There should now be a star shape with 12 triangular spokes.







Rnd 7: Continuing background section started in rnd 5.

Tip: Ignore all fpdtr2togs in this round, you are working in the exposed front loops from rnd 5 between each spoke. Work through the front loop of rnd 5 AND the front loop of the dc's in rnd 6, at the same time for each stitch in this round. This will be written as '2fl'. Your work may be slightly wavy after this round, do not worry, it will flatten back out.

Begin with yarn C in first st after a fpdtr2tog, attach yarn and ch 3 (counts as tr)

1 tr in next st (2fl) 2 tr in next st (2fl)

\* ch 1, skip fpdtr2tog, 2 tr in next st (2fl) 1 tr in next st (2fl) 2 tr in next st (2fl) \*

Repeat from \*to\* 10 times more, ending with a ch 1, skip fpdtr2tog and work 1 more tr through the same 2fl as first st made. ss to top of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

(60 tr, 12 ch-1-sp)



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Rnd 8: Popcorn round. Using Yarn A and working behind the rnd just made, into the back loops of rnd 6, attach yarn in blo of last dc before ch-sp, ch 3 (counts as tr)

\* fold rnd 7 back and work in front, make a popcorn into the top of the fpdtr2tog from rnd 6, now working behind rnd 7 again, work a tr into blo of first dc of next 3dc group rnd 6, ch 2, work a dc in blo of 3rd tr of 5tr group rnd 7, ch 2, tr behind into blo of last dc of 3dc group rnd 6\* Repeat from \*to\* 11 times more, omitting last tr, instead ss into top of beg ch-3. Fasten off. (12 popcorns, 24 tr's (into rnd 6 blo) 24 ch-2-sp's, 12 dc's (blo rnd 7) )







Rnd 9: Extending the background section with yarn C.

Tip: You will be working into the stitches from rnd 7, in front of the chains from rnd 8 (fold them back) when working the middle tr of the 5tr group you will work front loop only as this already has a st in. Also be mindful not to miss the first tr of each 5tr group as it may be partially hidden by the popcorn.

Begin with standing dc in any popcorn rnd 8

\* puff in each of next 5 sts of rnd 7 (middle one is flo) dc in popcorn rnd 8 \*

Repeat from \*to\* 11 times more, replacing final dc of repeat with a SS to first dc made. Fasten off.

(12 dc, 60 puffs)



Rnd 10: Circle outline.

With yarn B attach yarn in dc above popcorn, ch 2 (counts as htr) htr again in same st

\*htr in each of next 5 puff sts, work 2 htr in dc above popcorn\*

Repeat from \*to\* 11 times more, omitting 2htr on final repeat, SS to top of beg ch-2. Fasten off.

(84 htr)







Rnd 11: Using yarn D begin with a standing Bpdc, around the first st after a 2htr group, Bpdc around each of next 2 sts, \* Bphtr around each of next 3 sts, Bptr around each of next 3 sts, Bpdtr around next st, 3dtr into next st, Bpdtr around next st, Bptr around each of next 3 sts, Bphtr around each of next 3 sts, Bpdc around each of next 6 sts\* Repeat from \*to\* 3 times more, omitting 3 Bpdc on final repeat, SS to first dc made. DON'T fasten off.  
(20 dtr, 24 tr, 24 htr, 24 dc)



Rnd 12: continuing with yarn D ch 1, dc in each of next 4 sts  
\* htr in each of next 3 sts, tr in each of next 3 sts, in corner st (middle of 3dtr group) work: (tr, dtr, tr) tr in each of next 3 sts, htr in each of next 3 sts, dc in each of next 10 sts\*  
Repeat from \*to\* 3 times more, omitting 4 dc on final repeat. SS to first dc made. Fasten off.  
(4 dtr, 32 tr, 24 htr, 40 dc)







Rnd 13: Attach Denim in any st after corner with a standing dc  
\* dc in each st to corner, work 3 dc in corner st (the dtr)\*  
Repeat from \*to\* 3 times more, SS to first dc made. Fasten off.  
(108 dc, 27 dc along each edge)
