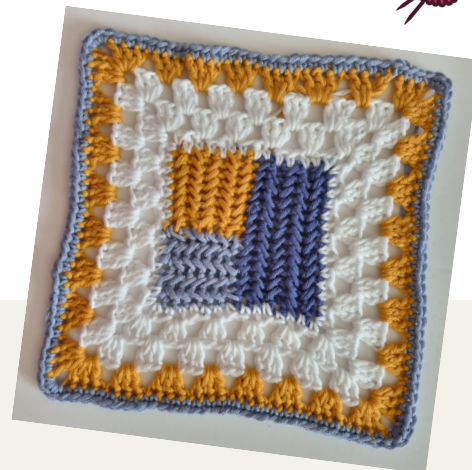

Abbreviations (UK terms)

ch - Chain

ch sp - Chain space

dc - Double Crochet

rnd - Round

sl st - Slip stitch

st - Stitch

sts - Stitches

tr - Treble Crochet

What you will need:

- Knitcraft Cotton Blend in Mustard (yarn A), Light Blue (Yarn B), Denim (Yarn C), White (Yarn D)
- 5mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

Pattern Notes

·hbbc - Herringbone Double Crochet - Insert hook behind left leg of current st, insert hook into next st, yarn around hook and pull up a loop, yarn around hook and pull through all 3 loops on hook.

rdc - Reverse Double Crochet - With WS facing you, insert hook from RS to WS into next st, yarn around hook and pull up a loop, yarn around hook, pull through 2 loops

rhbbc - Reverse Herringbone Double Crochet With WS facing you, insert hook behind left leg of current st from RS to WS, then insert hook from RS to WS insert hook into next st, yarn around hook and pull up a loop, yarn around hook and pull through all 3 loops on hook.

When working Herringbone pattern, ch 1 does not count as a st.

When working granny pattern in the round, ch3 counts as a tr throughout.



Starting with yarn A make a slip knot, ch9.

Row 1: starting in 2nd ch from hook, dc in back bump of ch, hbdc in back bump of each ch across, turn. 8sts

Row 2: ch 1, rdc in first st, rhbdc in every st across, turn. 8sts

Row 3: ch 1, dc in first st, hbdc in every st across, turn. 8 sts

Row 4: Rep Row 2. 8 sts

Row 5: Rep Row 3. 8 sts

Fasten off.



Attach yarn B in same st as you fastened yarn A off in.

Row 6: working into the side of the Rows from previous section, dc, hbdc 7 sts evenly across, turn. 8sts

Row 7: Rep Row 2. 8 sts

Row 8: Rep Row 3. 8 sts

Row 9: Rep Row 2. 8 sts

Row 10: Rep Row 3. 8 sts

Fasten off.





Attach yarn C in same st as you fastened yarn B off in.

Row 11: working into the side of the Rows from previous section, dc, hbbc 6 sts evenly across, hbbc in each st from yarn A section, turn. 15 sts

Row 12: Rep Row 2. 15 sts

Row 13: Rep Row 3. 15 sts

Row 14: Rep Row 2. 15 sts

Row 15: Rep Row 3. 15 sts

Fasten off.



Attach yarn D in same st as you fastened yarn C off in.

From this point on you will work in the round.

Rnd 1: 14 dc evenly across to corner, *ch2, dc in same st as last dc, 13 dc across to next corner* rep from * to * two more times until you reach the last corner, ch 2, sl st to first dc of rnd. 14 dc on each side of square (56 sts)



Rnd 2: Ch 3, *(skip 2 sts, 3tr in next st) 4 times, skip 2 sts, (3tr, ch2, 3tr) in ch-2-sp, rep from * twice, (skip 2 sts, 3tr in next st) 4 times, skip 2 sts, (3tr, ch2, 2tr) in ch-2-sp, sl st to top of 3ch. (72 sts)





Rnd 3: sl st in next 2 sts, sl st in between current tr and next tr, ch 3, 2tr, *ch 1, skip 2, 3tr in next st* rep until 2 sts remain before next corner, skip 2, ch 1 (3tr, ch2, 3tr) in ch 2 sp**, rep from * to ** three times around, ch 1, sl st to 3rd ch of starting ch. 7 groups of 3 tr on each side of square (84 sts)



Fasten off.

Attach yarn A in ch 1 sp before the st as you fastened yarn D off in.

Rnd 4: Rep Rnd 3. 8 groups of 3 tr on each side of square (96 sts)





Fasten off.

Attach yarn B in same st as you fastened yarn D off in.

Rnd 5: dc in same st, *dc in each st to corner ch 2 sp, 3dc in ch 2 sp* rep from * around, dc in any remain sts, sl st to first dc of rnd. (108 sts)



Fasten off. Weave in all ends and steam block to 20cm x 20cm
