## Abbreviations (UK terms)

- Magic Ring
- Ch Chain
- Ss Slip Stitch
- Dc Double Crochet
- Tr- Trebles
- Htr half treble crochet
- Dtr double treble crochet

## What you will need:

- Knitcraft Cotton Blend in Black (yarn A), White (yarn B), Hot Pink (yarn C), Light Grey (yarn D
- 5mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

Rnd 1 – Using yarn A, make a magic ring, ch3 to create the first tr, 11tr into the ring. Pull the ring closed and ss into the top of the ch3. Fasten off. (12 sts)















Rnd 2 – Join yarn C between any of the tr gaps, ch1 (counts as the first dc), (ch5, skip 2 trs, dc into the next gap) rep 5 more times, ss into the back of your first ch1. Fasten off. (6 ch-5-sps)



Rnd 3 Join yarn B between any 2tr in rnd 1 (between 2 yarn C dcs working behind yarn C from rnd 2). Ch3, (counts as 1tr), (1tr, 1ch, 2tr) into same sp, \*skip the next 2trs in Rnd1, (2tr, 1ch 2tr) into gap, rep from \* 4 more times, ss into the top of the first ch3. Fasten off.



Rnd 4 – Join yarn D in any gap before (2tr, 1ch, 2tr) of previous row, ch3, (this will be above the yarn C dc in rnd 2), 1tr in the same sp, 1tr in the next 3 sps between trs, (2tr in next sp, 1tr in next 3 sps) 5 times. Fasten off. (30sts)









Rnd 5 – Join yarn C in the FLO of any tr, ch2, 2htr into the same st, (4htr into the FLO of the next st, 3htr into the FLO of the next st) 14 times, 3htr into the FLO of the next st, ss into the top of ch2. Fasten off.



Rnd 6 – We will now work behind the ruffle into the BLO of rnd 4. Join yarn A into the BLO of any tr in Rnd 4, ch<sub>3</sub>, 2tr into BLO of next st in Rnd 4, (1tr into BLO, 2tr into BLO) 14 times, ss into the top of ch<sub>2</sub>. Fasten off. (45sts)



NOTE: Try not to crochet too tightly in this row

Rnd 7 – Join the yarn D in the top of any tr, ch2, 1htr into the same st, 1htr into the next 4 sts, (2htr into the next st, 1htr into the next 4 sts) 8 times, ss into the ch2. Fasten off. (54sts)



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Rnd 8 – Join yarn C in any space between 2htr in Rnd 7, ch1, (counts as first dc), ch3, (skip 3htr, dc into the next gap, 3ch) 17 times, skip 3htr, ss into first ch. Fasten off. (18 ch-3-sps)



Rnd 9 – Join yarn B in any of the yarn C ch-3-sps in Rnd 8. ch3 (count as first tr), (1tr, ch1, 2tr) into the same sp, 1ch, \*(2tr, ch1, 2tr, ch1) into next ch-3-sp, rep from \* 16 times more, ss into the top of the first ch3. Fasten off. (72 tr)



Rnd 10 – Join yarn A in any ch-1-sp of Rnd 9,

You're going to start by making the first corner, ch3 (counts as first tr), (1tr, 1dtr, ch2, 1dtr, 2tr) all into the same sp, \*2tr in next ch-1-sp, (2dc in next ch-1-sp) 6 times, 2tr in next ch-1-sp, (2tr, 1dtr, ch2, 1dtr, 2tr) all into next ch-1-sp, rep from \* twice more, 2tr in next ch-1-sp, (2dc in next ch-1-sp) 6 times, 2tr in next ch-1-sp. Ss into top of ch3. Fasten off (22 sts along each side)

It might not look 100% square at this stage, but the subsequent rows will straighten it out further.



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Rnd 11 - Join yarn D in any corner ch-2-sp,

ch3, (counts as first tr), (2tr, ch3, 3tr) into the same ch-2-sp, \*(2tr into space between each pair of sts on rnd 10) 9 times, (3tr, ch3, 3tr) into ch-2-sp, rep from \* twice more, (2tr into space between each pair of sts on rnd 10) 9 times, ss into the top of the first ch3. Fasten off. (24 sts along each side)



Rnd 12- In this round we're going to surface crochet onto Rnd 11 using yarn C.

Start with the yarn behind the work and insert your hook into any space between trs from the front to back of your square.

Pull a loop from the back through the gap.

Move to the next tr along, push your hook into the next space between trs and pull the yarn from behind the square to the surface. This will look like little chain stitches. Do this all the way around the square. So every tr in rnd 11 has a pink surface stitch around in.


When you reach your first stitch pull the yarn about an inch above your work and cut. Using your crochet hook, pull this to the back of the square and tie to the starting thread to secure in place.



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Rnd 13 – Join yarn B in top of any tr in Rnd 11, ch1, (counts as first dc), \*1dc in every st to corner, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in ch-3-sp, rep from \* 3 times more, 1dc in every st to beg of rnd, ss into ch1. Fasten off. (26 sts along each side)



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Rn14 – Join yarn A in any dc from Rnd 13, ch1, (counts as first dc), \*1dc in every st to corner, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in ch-1-sp, rep from \* 3 times more, 1dc in every st to beg of rnd, ss into ch1. Fasten off. (28 sts along each side) Weave in ends.



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
