## ABBREVIATIONS

NB - These instructions use UK crochet terms throughout - US terms are shown in square brackets below where applicable
beg - beginning
ch - chain
cl - cluster (a group of 3 stitches all worked into the same place) cl sp - cluster space (the space between last stitch of cluster and the first stitch of the next cluster)
cm - centimetres
dc - double crochet [US single crochet]
in - inch(es)
rs - right side
sp - space
ss - slip stitch
tr - treble [US double crochet]

## Notes

Sew your ends in with a tapestry needle, weaving back and forth through the back of your work. Always leave a tail of 15 cm , ( 6 in ) when changing yarns or fastening off so you can sew in at least 8cm, (3in) to secure your work.

## WEEK 2 CAL PATTERN

## HALF N HALF SQUARE

Make 4 in Colourway I and 4 in Colourway 2

## SIDE I

Foundation Chain. Using Yarn B (Colourway I) or Yarn A (Colourway 2) and 4.00 hook make 4ch, ss into Ist ch to form a ring.
I st Row (rs). 4ch (4ch counts as Itr and $I \mathrm{ch}$ ), 3 tr into centre of ring, 2 ch , 3 tr into centre of ring, Ich, Itr into centre of ring, turn.
2nd Row. 4ch, 3tr into Ich sp, (3tr,
$2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) into 2 ch corner sp, Ich, (3tr, Ich, Itr) into next Ich sp, turn.
Total of 23 tr cl and Itr along each side edge.
3rd Row. 4ch, 3tr into Ich sp, 3tr into next cl sp, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) into 2ch corner sp, 3tr into next cl sp, (3tr, Ich, Itr) into next Ich sp, turn.
Total of 3 3tr cl and Itr along each side edge.
4th Row. 4ch, 3tr into Ich sp, (3tr


## HALF N HALF SQUARE

Week 2 takes what we learnt last week and puts a new spin on it. The Half $N$ Half square mixes the traditional Granny look with bold block treble crochet stripes.

This square is made in 2 halves, starting with the solid colour granny triangle and then attaching the second side as you go. In the first half granny treble clusters are worked into the spaces between clusters. For the second half you'll work between stitches.

You'll make 4 motifs in each colourway, 8 squares in total.

## THIS WEEK'S STITCH HOW TO'S

## CHAIN

To start, make a slip knot and place loop on hook. To make I chain, yarn over hook and draw yarn through loop on hook.

## SLIP STITCH

Insert hook into the stitch or space indicated in pattern, yarn over hook and draw yarn through both the stitch or space and loop on hook.

## TREBLE CROCHET STITCH

Yarn over hook, insert hook into stitch or space indicated in pattern, yarn over hook, draw yarn through stitch or space (3 loops on hook), yarn over hook and draw yarn through Ist 2 loops on hook (2 loops left on hook), yarn over hook and draw yarn through last 2 loops on hook.

## NEW THIS WEEK - DOUBLE CROCHET JOIN

Make a slip knot and place loop on hook, insert hook into stitch or space indicated in pattern, yarn over hook and draw through (2 loops on hook), yarn over hook and draw through both loops on hook.

## NEW THIS WEEK - DOUBLE

 CROCHET STITCHInsert hook into stitch or space indicated in pattern, yarn over hook, draw yarn through stitch or space (2 loops on hook), yarn over hook and draw yarn through both loops on hook.

## NEW THIS WEEK - TREBLE CROCHET STITCH BETWEEN STITCHES

This is similar to the traditional treble stitch but instead of working into the top of the stitch, insert your hook into the gap between the posts of each treble stitch then work treble as usual.

## NEW THIS WEEK - JOIN IN NEW COLOUR WITH SLIP STITCH AS YOU GO

After working the last stitch before changing colour, cut the yarn but don't fasten off, draw new colour yarn through loop on hook and pull both colours tight to secure.

## FASTEN OFF

With the last loop still on hook, cut the yarn (leaving a long enough tail for weaving the end in) then yarn over hook and draw end of yarn all the way through loop on hook. Pull tight to secure.
into next cl sp) twice, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) into next 2ch corner sp, (3tr into next cl sp ) twice, (3tr, Ich, Itr) into next Ich sp, turn. Total of 43 tr cl and Itr along each side edge.
5th Row. 4ch, 3tr into Ich sp, (3tr into next cl sp) 3 times, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) into next 2ch corner sp, (3tr into next $\mathrm{cl} \mathrm{sp}) 3$ times, ( $3 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{Ich}, \mathrm{Itr}$ ) into next Ich sp, turn. Total of 53 tr cl and Itr along each side edge.
6th Row. 4ch, 3tr into Ich sp, (3tr into next cl sp) 4 times, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) into next 2ch corner sp, (3tr into next $\mathrm{cl} \mathrm{sp}) 4$ times, (3tr, Ich, Itr) into next Ich sp. Total of 63 tr cl and Itr along each side edge.
Fasten off.

## SIDE 2

Ist Row. Yarn G (Colourway I) or Yarn B (Colourway 2):- With rs of Side I facing you and the long side of the triangle uppermost, join in Yarn G or Yarn B with a dc join over the post of Itr to the right of the centre ring (this dc join is an anchoring st), (3tr, $2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) into centre ring of Side I, Idc anchor over the post of Itr to the left of the centre ring, do not turn.
2nd Row. 3ch (3ch counts as Itr), Idc anchor over the next Itr post of Side I (at end of 2 nd row/Side I), turn, Itr into sp below dc on which 3ch stands (sp between Side I and this side), (Itr into $s p$ between next 2 tr ) twice, ( 2 tr , $2 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ ) into corner 2 ch sp , (Itr into sp between next 2 tr) twice, 2 tr into $s p$ below Idc joining anchor, Idc anchor over the post of $\operatorname{Itr}$ (at beg 2nd row/ Side I), do not turn. Total of 6tr along each side edge.
3rd Row. Yarn A (Colourway I) or Yarn F (Colourway 2):- Change to Yarn A or Yarn F with a ss as you go, 3ch, Idc anchor over the next Itr post (at end of 3rd row/Side I), turn, Itr into sp below dc on which 3ch stands, (Itr into sp between next 2 tr ) 5 times, ( $2 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ ) into corner 2 ch sp , ( 1 tr into sp between next 2 tr) 5 times, 2 tr into sp below Idc joining anchor, Idc anchor over post of Itr (at beg 3rd row/Side I), do not turn. Total of 9tr along each side edge.
4th Row. 3ch, Idc anchor over next Itr post (at end of 4th row/Side I), turn, Itr into sp below dc on which 3ch stands, (Itr into sp between next
$2 \mathrm{tr}) 8$ times, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) into corner 2 ch sp , (Itr into sp between next 2tr) 8 times, 2 tr into sp below Idc joining anchor, Idc anchor over post of Itr (at beg 4th row/Side I), do not turn. Total of 12 tr along each side edge. 5th Row. Yarn D (Colourway I) or Yarn C (Colourway 2):- Change to Yarn D or Yarn C with a ss as you go, 3ch, Idc anchor over the next Itr post (at end of 5th row/Side I), turn, Itr into sp below dc on which 3ch stands, (Itr into sp between next 2tr) II times, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) into corner 2ch sp, (ltr into sp between next 2tr) II times, 2tr into sp below Idc joining anchor, Idc anchor over post of Itr (at beg 5th row/Side I), do not turn. Total of 15 tr along each side edge. 6th Row. 3ch, Idc anchor over the next Itr post (at end of 6th row/ Side I), turn, Itr into sp below dc on which 3ch stands, (Itr into sp between next 2tr) 14 times, ( 2 tr, 2ch, 2tr) into corner 2ch sp, (ltr into sp between next 2 tr) 14 times, 2 tr into sp below Idc joining anchor, Idc anchor over post of Itr (at beg 6th row/Side I). Total of 18 tr along each side edge. Fasten off and weave in ends.
