Abbreviations (UK terms)

- ch Chain
- ss Slip Stitch
- tr Treble Crochet
- htr- Half Treble Crochet

 - dc Double Crochet
- BLO Back Loop Only
 - [] indicates stitches to be done in the same space/stitch

 Knitcraft Cotton Blend in Light Blue (yarn A), Bright Blue (Yarn B), Yellow (Yarn C), Hot Pink (Yarn D), Teal (Yarn E), White (Yarn F), Mustard (Yarn G), Black (Yarn H)

knit

- 5mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors





Pattern Notes

The 1st tr / BPtr of each rnd can be worked either as ch 3 or standing dc (ch 2 or standing htr for the first htr / BPhtr).
Each rnd starts directly above the first st of the previous rnd unless stated otherwise.

•Finish each round by joining to the top of the first st of the rnd with a sl st. Charts for all rnds and photos can be found below the written instructions BBL - Bobble Stitch - * YO insert hook into stitch, YO and pull through.YO and pull through first two stitches on hook (2 hoops remaining on hook). Rep from * 4 more times in the same stitch (6 loops on hook). YO and pull through all 6 loops.







Using yarn A; ch3, ss into 1st ch to make a loop.

Rnd 1 Ch3, 2tr into centre of loop. (ch2, 3tr into centre) 3 times, ch2, ss into 3rd ch of beginning ch3. (12 tr, 4 ch-2-sp)



Rnd 2 Ch3, (tr into each st to corner ch-2-sp, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) into corner ch-2-sp) 4 times, ss into 3rd ch of beginning ch3. (28 tr, 4 ch-2-sp)



Rnd 3 Ch3, (tr in each st to corner ch-2-sp, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) into corner ch-2-sp) 4 times, 1tr into each st to beg of rnd, ss into 3rd ch of beginning ch3. (44 tr, 4 ch-2-sp)



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Rnd 4 Ch1 (does NOT count as a stitch), (htr into each st to corner ch-2-sp, (2htr, ch2, 2htr) into corner ch-2-sp) 4 times, htr in each st to beg of rnd, ss to first htr. (60 htr, 4 ch-2-sp)

Rnd 5 Slip st into next st, ch3, 2tr into same st, (skip 2 sts, 3tr into the next) twice, skip the final 2 sts, (3tr, ch2, 3tr) into the corner ch-2-sp, (skip the first 3 sts, 3tr into the next st, (*skip 2 sts, 3tr into the next, rep from * until 2 sts rem on this side, skip the final 2 sts, (3tr, ch2, 3tr) into the corner ch-2-sp) 3 times, skip 2 sts, 3tr into the next, skip 2 sts, ss to 3rd ch of beginning ch3. Fasten off. (72 tr, 4 ch-2-sp)



Rnd 6 Join yarn B to any corner space, ch1 (does NOT count as a stitch), (2htr, ch2, 2htr) into corner ch-2-sp, *FPhtr, BPhtr,* rep from * to * along sides, working (2htr, ch2, 2htr) in each corner ch-2-sp, ss to first htr. Fasten off. (16 htr, 36 FPhtr, 36BPtr, 4 ch-2-sp)



Rnd 7 With WS facing, join yarn C to any corner space; ch1 (does NOT count as a stitch); (dc, ch2, dc) into corner ch-2-sp, *BBL, dc* - rep from * to * until you have 2 sts rem on this side, BBL into next stitch and skip the final stitch. Rep this for each side and corner, then ss to first dc. Fasten off. (44 BBL, 48 dc, 4 ch-2-sp)

Rnd 8 With RS facing, join yarn D to any st; ch1 (does NOT count as a stitch), dc in each st around, working (dc, ch2, dc) in each corner ch-2-sp, ss to first dc. Fasten off. (100 dc, 4 ch-2-sp)



Rnd 9 Join yarn E to any corner ch-2-sp, ch1 (does NOT count as a stitch), htr into BLO of each st around, working (2htr, ch2, 2htr) in each corner ch-2-sp, ss to first htr. Fasten off. (108 htr, 4 ch-2-sp)



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Rnd 10 Join yarn F to any st; ch1 (does NOT count as a stitch), dc in each st around, working (dc, ch2, dc) in each corner Ch-2-sp, ss to first dc. Fasten off.


(116 dc, 4 ch-2-sp)



For the sunshine appliqué:

Using yarn C; ch₃, ss into 1st ch to make a loop.

Rnd 1 Ch1 (does NOT count as a stitch throughout), 6 dc into loop, ss to first dc. (6 dc)



Rnd 2 Ch1, 2dc in each st, ss to first dc. (12 dc)



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Rnd 3 Ch1, (2 dc in next st, 1dc) 6times, ss to first dc. (18 dc)



Rnd 4 Ch1, (2dc in next st, 2dc) 6 times, ss to first dc. (24 dc)



Rnd 5 Ch1, (2dc in next st, 3dc) 6 times, ss to first dc. (30 dc)



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Rnd 6 Ch1, (2dc in next st, 4dc) 6 times, ss to first dc. (36 dc)



Rnd 7 Ch1, dc in each st around, ss to first dc. Fasten off.



Rnd 8 Join yarn G to BLO of any st; ch1, working into BLO for this round (2dc in next st, 3dc) 9 times, ss to first dc. (45 dc)



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Rnd 9 Ch1, ss into same stitch. *1htr, (1tr, ch3, ss into 3rd ch from hook, 1tr) all in next st, 1htr, ss into next st, * rep from * to * 9 more times. 1htr, (1tr, ch3, ss into 3rd ch from hook, 1tr) all in next st, 1htr, ss into first ss to join. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



Using yarn H; with a darning or sewing needle, stitch a pair of eyes and a smile onto your sunshine appliqué.



Position your sunshine appliqué onto the centre of the square. Using the long tail remaining from finishing the appliqué, sew your appliqué onto the centre of the square. When sewing, go through the backs of the dc stitches of round 9 and only through the fronts of the nearest stitches on the square to prevent the stitch-work showing.



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
