## Materials

Women's Institute Premium Acrylic DK in:
Honey (yarn A) 3 balls
Plum (yarn B) 2 balls
Mustard (yarn C) 2 balls
Red (yarn D) 1 ball
Orange (yarn E) 1 ball
Brown (yarn F) 2 balls
Cream (yarn G) 3 balls
Green (yarn H) 2 balls
School Green (yarn I) 2 balls
4 mm hook
Scissors
Tapestry needle
Stitch markers

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## Pattern Notes

## Tension

17 sts and 10 rows to 10 cm of treble crochet using 4 mm hook.

## Measurements

The blanket measures $125 \mathrm{~cm} \times 165 \mathrm{~cm}$ ( 49 " x 65")

## Abbreviations <br> (UK Terms)

Ch: chain
Ch-sp: chain space
Ss: slip stitch
St(s): stitch(es)
Yrh: yarn round hook
Beg: beginning
Dc: double crochet
Htr: half treble crochet
Tr: treble crochet
Dtr: double treble crochet
Spike dc: work a dc into the row below, at the base of the st already made.
RS: right side facing (front)
WS: wrong side facing (back)

## Notes

Part One 'Carpet of Leaves': rows $1-29$, then add rows $24-29$ to foundation ch.
Part Two 'Fields of Gold': rows 30-40 on both edges + appliqués.
Part Three 'Toadstool Time": rows 41-59 on both edges.
Part Four 'Basket of Berries': rows 60-81 on both edges.
Part Five 'Pumpkin Patch': rows 82-101 on both edges.
Part Six 'Fir Cones': rows 102-118 on both edges.
Part Seven: Edging.

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
